Dear Colleague:

The 45th Annual Conference on Historical and Underwater Archaeology will be held in Baltimore on January 4–7, 2012 and will include an estimated 800 scholarly presentations on all aspects of historical archaeology. The conference theme is By the Dawn's Early Light: Forging Identity, Securing Freedom, and Overcoming Conflict. The year 2012 marks the bicentennial of the War of 1812. This makes Baltimore, the site of a major turning point in the war and the nation's history, the ideal location for this year's conference.

Formed in 1967, the Society for Historical Archaeology (SHA) is the largest scholarly group concerned with the archaeology of the modern world (A.D. 1400-present). The main focus of the Society is the era since the beginning of European exploration. SHA promotes scholarly research and the dissemination of knowledge concerning historical archaeology. The Society is specifically concerned with the identification, excavation, interpretation, and conservation of sites and materials on land and underwater. Geographically, the SHA emphasizes the New World, but also includes European exploration and settlements in Africa, Asia, and Oceania.

In addition to the educational presentations by archaeologists from around the world, the Conference will host an Archaeology Market Place that will include exhibits of products, services and publications from companies and other organizations in the archaeological community. SHA welcomes exhibitors who share its mission and code of ethics at the 2012 Conference on Historical and Underwater Archaeology. We hope that you will join us in Baltimore, Maryland, January 4–7, 2012 at the Baltimore Marriott Waterfront Hotel.

Each manned display will receive one (1) 6'x 30" skirted table and two (2) chairs. For the unmanned tables, we will have a section in the ballroom designated for your materials. Each exhibit should be installed so as not to obstruct the view of, or interfere with, the exhibits of others.

Each manned table entitles an organization to one (1) full conference registration and one (1) exhibitor staff registration. A full conference registration includes entry to paper presentations and complimentary special events. The exhibitor staff registration includes entry to the complimentary special events only. Exhibitors are welcome to purchase tickets for events with a fee (i.e., Thursday's Reception, Awards Banquet).



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All interested vendors must complete an application/contract for exhibit space. Please be aware that *space is limited* and will be allocated on a first come, first-served basis. In the event that your preferred space is unavailable, SHA staff will call you to discuss alternate locations. Full payment must accompany your completed Exhibitor Contract to ensure processing. Once contracts are received, a confirmation packet will be sent with information concerning conference registration, shipping and electrical, and telephone connections. The SHA reserves the right to alter the floorplan or to relocate tables at its discretion.
